Westport native Jeff Pegues, track and football standout at Staples High School, is the CBS News Justice and Homeland Security Correspondent based in Washington, D.C. Since joining CBS News in July 2013, Pegues has led the Network's coverage of some of the biggest stories of the last decade. From the Russia investigation to a number of recent terrorist attacks, Pegues' reporting is often the leading story on the CBS Evening News. In addition, he has become one of the most informed voices on the conflict between the black community and police. Not only has he reported extensively on recent police actions and Justice Department investigations in Baltimore and Ferguson but he has also written a book on the issue entitled *Black and Blue: Inside the Divide Between Police and the Black Community*. Pegues has become one of the most visible and informed journalists on the investigation into Russian interference in the U.S. election. His upcoming book, *Kompromat: How Russia Undermined American Democracy*, will investigate how Russian President Vladimir Putin's hackers poked into U.S. voter databases and what is now being done to shore up election systems in states across the country. He is the recipient of three Emmy Awards, numerous Emmy Award nominations, the Sigma Delta Chi Award from the Society of Professional Journalists, and in 2017 was part of the CBS News team that earned an Edward R. Murrow Award.
